PETRONAS CARIGALI AWARDS 5 CONTRACTS

Local players bag topside major maintenance and facilities improvement deals

PETROLIAM Nasional Bhd's (Petronas) unit, Petronas Carigali Sdn Bhd, has awarded contracts to provide maintenance, construction and modification services at its offshore facilities in Malaysia to five local players.

Carimin Engineering Services Sdn Bhd, Dayang Enterprise Sdn Bhd, Deleum Primera Sdn Bhd, Petra Resources Sdn Bhd and Sapura Fabrication Sdn Bhd, with its joint venture partner Borneo Seaoffshore Engineering Sdn Bhd, were selected for five-year contracts, each with an option to extend for another year, effective September last year.

"Under the terms of the contract, the engineering and maintenance services will include topside major maintenance and fa-

cilities improvement projects," said Petronas Carigali in a statement yesterday.

Petronas Carigali vice-president of Malaysia assets and chief executive officer Mohd Jukris Abdul Wahab said the new requirements were to encourage collaboration in the industry's supply chain.

"These contracts encompass requirements such as the utilisation of marine vessels from Malaysian-owned companies only and the 20 per cent manda-

tory participation of local service providers to spur value-added services and ensures growth in Malaysia's oil and gas upstream services industry," said Jukris.

With 200 offshore platforms in operation under Petronas Carigali in Malaysia, Petronas continues to encourage merit-based participation from local contractors to achieve value-driven production growth for the long-term progress and sustainability of the oil and gas industry.
