## Lending a helping hand

THE Malaysian Oil & Gas Services Council (MOGSC) recently joined hands with the Malaysian Oil & Gas Engineering Council (MOGEC) to organise a charity golf event, aimed at securing a mobile clinic for Yayasan Semesta Berdaftar.

The event was promoted by Petronita, the Petronas' Wives and Women Employees Association.

Among the guests who turned up to lend their support for this worthy cause were Petronas group chief executive officer Tan Sri Shamsul Azhar Abbas, Petronas Upstream vice-president and chief executive officer Datuk Wee Yaw Hin and Petronas executive vice-president and group chief financial officer Datuk Manharlal Ratilal.

On behalf of the association, Petronita president Puan Sri Sharifah Salwa Syed Kamaruddin received the cheques donated by 26 oil and gas companies, that amounted to RM447,750.

The total cost of the mobile clinic was estimated at RM350,000, including costs of

the van and medical equipment.

Among the companies that chipped in were Petronas Lubricants International Sdn Bhd, Halliburton Energy Services (M) Sdn Bhd, Petra Energy Berhad, Deleum Berhad, Schlumberger WTA (M) Sdn Bhd, Dialog Asia, Bumi Armada Berhad and Asian Supply Base Sdn Bhd an.

Sharifah Salwa said the underprivileged communities will certainly benefit from the mobile clinic as it provides easy access to medical check-ups and medication, which are also sponsored by Kumpulan Perubatan Johor (KPJ). Free blood pressure check-ups, body mass index (BMI) and physiotherapy were available during the event which was held at the Glenmarie Golf & Country Club.

Thirteen nurses and medical personnel from Kumpulan Perubatan Johor (KPJ), Pusat Perubatan University Malaya (PPUM), Pusrawi International College of Medical Sciences (PICOMs) and Persatuan Bulan Sabit Merah (PBSM) were on duty to provide the medical check-ups.
